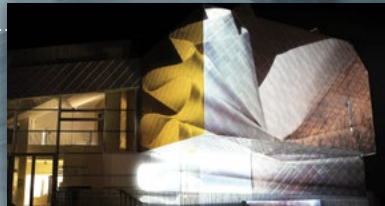

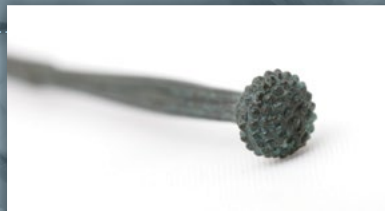

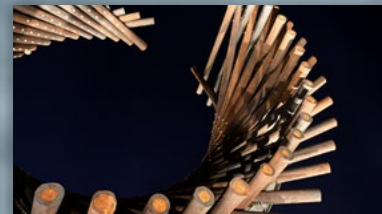

Clár Éire Ildánach

Bhí Scéim *Deontais um Chultúr & Cruthaitheachta*, tacaíocht do Scéim Deontas Pobail Cholmille 1500, tionscadail chruthaitheacha chun cur le Tionscnamh Bhailte Stairiúla Bhéal Átha Seanaidh, gradam agus scéim sparánachta um scannán tionscnaimh, chomh maith le forbairt leanúnach maidir le clár *Colmille 1500*, ar chlár 2021. Bhí beagnach €223,000 ar fáil don chlár.

Creative Ireland Programme

The 2021 programme included the *Culture & Creativity Grant Scheme*, support for the Colmille 1500 Community Grant Scheme, creative projects to complement the Ballyshannon Historic Towns Initiative, an inaugural film award and bursary scheme, and ongoing development of the wider *Colmille 1500* programme. Just over €223K was available for the programme.

Forbairt Lucht Féachana

Cuireadh Plean Forbartha Lucht Féachana Trasteorann, a dréachtaíodh in 2020, i bhfeidhm in 2021, a dhírigh ar Theaghlaigh agus Seandaoine. Tá Dún na nGall chun tosaigh maidir le clár na Seandaoine, agus Comhairle Chathair Dhoire agus Cheantar an tSraitha Báin chun tosaigh maidir le clár na dTeaghlach. Is iad na sé thionscnamh do Sheandaoine ná painéal sainiúil don chultúr a fhorbairt, iniúchtaí Inrochtaineachta, a bheith ag Obair le hOifigigh a Thacaíonn le Seandaoine, Síneadh le Féile na Bealtaine, Ealaíontóir Cónaithe do Thithe Cúraim, agus Comrádaithe Cultúir.

Cruinniú na nÓg

Bhí lá náisiúnta na cruthaitheachta, *Cruinniú na nÓg*, ar siúl Dé Sathairn an 12 Meitheamh. Rinne Foireann Chruinniú na nÓg 23 imeacht ar fud Dhún na nGall a chomhordú, inar áiríodh meascán d'imeachtaí beo ar líne agus réamhthairfeadta bunaithe ar thionscadail chomh maith le pacáistí gníomhaíochta a cuireadh sa phost nó a bailíodh. Ghlac os cionn 1,000 páiste agus duine óg páirt ghníomhach ann roimh ré agus ar an lá féin. D'amharc breis agus 6,000 duine ar na trí imeacht réamhthairfeadta, bhí tionscadal pobalbhunaithe le Lár Chomhairle Paróiste Ghleann Cholm Cille, tionscadal scoile ar shaol Cholmcille ag Scoil Náisiúnta Ghartáin agus mionfhéile ceoil ar líne mar chuid de. Bhí tionscnaimh náisiúnta ar fáil do rannpháirtithe Dhún na nGall fosta.

Audience Development

The Cross-border Audience Development Plan, drawn up in 2020, began to be implemented in 2021, with a focus on Families and on Older People. Donegal is taking the lead on the Older People strand, with Derry City & Strabane District Council leading on the Families programme. The six initiatives for Older People are Development of a culture specific panel, Accessibility audits, Working with Age Friendly Officers, Extension of the Bealtaine Festival, Artist in Residence for Care Homes, and Cultural Companions.

Cruinniú na nÓg

The national day of creativity, *Cruinniú na nÓg*, took place on Saturday June 12th. The Cruinniú team coordinated the programme of 23 events across Donegal, which included a combination of live online and pre-recorded project-based events, and hands on activity packs which were either posted or collected. Over 1,000 children and young people actively participated in the run up to and on the day itself. An audience of over 6,000 people viewed the three pre-recorded events combined, which included a community based project by Lár Chomhairle Paróiste Ghleann Cholm Cille, a school project on the life of Colmcille by Gartan National School and an online mini music festival. National initiatives were also available to Donegal participants.

Scéim Deontas Pobail

Thairg an Scéim Deontas um Chultúr & Chruthaitheacht deontais ar fiú €2,000 an ceann iad do thionscadail a spreagann comhoibriú idir pobail agus speisialtóirí oidhreachta, ealaíontóirí, gairmithe cultúir agus/ nó tionscail chruthaitheacha. D'fhéadfadh grúpaí pobail agus daoine aonair iarratas a dhéanamh ar mhaoiniú do thionscadal a thugann aghaidh ar thionscail chultúir, oidhreachta, ealaíon nó chruthaitheacha.

Ciste um Ghníomhú Cruthaitheach ar son na hAeráide

Rinne an Chomhairle, i gcomhpháirt le Comhairle Contae an Chláir agus *LUXe Professional & Landscape Theatre*, iarratas ar thionscadal ar fiú €200K dar teideal *FLOW*, freagairt ealaíne ar lagú na gcóras imshruthaithe aigéin san Atlantach mar gheall ar athrú aeráide. Bhí ró-éileamh ar an Chiste, agus níor éirigh ach le 14 de na 166 iarratas. Mar fhocal dearfach, beidh Dún na nGall i measc na n-iarratas rathúil mar *Stories of Change* - rachaidh seó bóthair cruthaitheach idirghlúine go ceithre chontae a thaispeánfaidh réitigh áitiúla ar ghéarchéim na haeráide trí mheán na grianghrafadóireachta, na scéalaíochta agus an bhia.

An Ciste um Chruthaitheacht i nDúshlán na Seanaoise

Cuireadh dhá iarratas faoi bhráid an Chiste um Dhúshlán Cruthaitheachta i measc na Seanaoise agus d'éirigh leis an dá cheann. Thug sé seo an seans síneadh a chur leis an chlár *Music in Care Homes* agus tabhairt faoi thionscadal scannáin dar teideal *Yarns* - sraith gearrscannán ina raibh amhráin, scéalta agus cuimhní cinn ó chúigear seandaoine cruthaitheacha i nDún na nGall.

Community Grants Scheme

The Culture & Creativity Grants Scheme offered grants of €2,000 each to projects that encourage cooperation and collaboration between communities and heritage specialists, artists, culture professionals and/or creative industries. Community groups and individuals could apply for funding for a project that addresses culture, heritage, arts or creative industries.

85 applications were received and 25 projects were supported. Information on each of the projects is on the Creative Ireland website <https://www.creativeireland.gov.ie/en/donegal/>

Separately, support was provided for the Colmcille 1500 Community Grant Scheme, to enable projects during the commemorative year.

Creative Climate Action Fund

The Council, in partnership with Clare County Council and *LUXe Processional & Landscape Theatre*, made an application for a €200K project entitled *FLOW*, an artistic response to the weakening of ocean circulation systems in the Atlantic due to climate change. The Fund was hugely oversubscribed, with only 14 of the 166 applications being successful. On a positive note, one of the successful applications will include *Donegal as Stories of Change* - an intergenerational creative roadshow will travel to four counties showcasing local solutions to the climate crisis through the visual medium of photography, storytelling and food.

Creativity in Older Age Challenge Fund

Two applications were submitted to the Creativity in Older Age Challenge Fund and both were successful. This allowed for an extension of the *Music in Care Homes* programme and for a film project entitled *Yarns* - a series of short films featuring songs, stories, and reminiscences from five creative older people in Donegal.

Colmcille 1500

Comóradh bliana is ea *Colmcille 1500* a dhéanann ceiliúradh ar chuimhneachán 1500 bliain ó rugadh Columba, nó Colmcille mar is fearr aithne air. Aithníonn sé tábhacht agus oidhreacht an naoimh ón 6ú haois, ní hamháin do mhuintir Dhún na nGall agus Dhoire ach do mhuintir na hÉireann, na hAlban agus dóibh siúd ar fud an domhain. Mhair an ceiliúradh bliana ón 7 Nollaig 2020 go dtí an 7 Nollaig 2021 agus síneadh curtha le roinnt gníomhaíochtaí go 2022.

Chomhoibrigh Comhairle Contae Dhún na nGall agus Comhairle Chathair Dhoire agus Cheantar an tSraitha Báin ar chlár ar feadh na bliana le maoiniú ó Chiste Forbartha an Iarthuaiscirt. Cuireann sé le hiniúchadh ar Oidhreacht Cholm Cille a rinneadh in 2018 agus tá sé mar aidhm leis feasacht agus tuiscint ar Cholm Cille a ardú chomh maith le hoidhreacht mharthanach a bhunú. Chlúdaigh an maoiniú réimse tionscadal, imeachtaí agus gníomhaíochtaí chomh maith le scéim deontas, cursaí margaíochta agus Bainisteoir Tionscadail tiomnaithe. Thacaigh an clár le Grúpa Stiúrtha trasteorann agus chuathas i dteagmháil le páirtithe leasmhara ar leibhéal náisiúnta agus idirnáisiúnta.

Colmcille 1500

Colmcille 1500 is a year-long commemoration marking the 1500th anniversary of the birth of Colmcille, also known as Columba. It recognises the importance and legacy of the 6th-century saint, not only for Donegal and Derry but for Ireland, Scotland and across the world. The year-long celebrations lasted from the 7th December 2020 to 7th December 2021 with some activity extending into 2022.

Donegal County Council and Derry City and Strabane District Council co-ordinated a programme for the year, primarily funded through the North West Development Fund. It builds on an Audit of Columban Heritage undertaken in 2018 and aims to raise knowledge and understanding of Colmcille as well as establish a lasting legacy. Funding covered a range of projects, events and activities as well as a grants scheme, marketing and a dedicated Project Manager. The programme supported a cross-border Steering Group and engaged with stakeholders at a national and international level.

Imeachtaí Colmcille 1500

Bhí breis agus 150 imeacht ar siúl le linn 2021 ag comhpháirtithe áitiúla, réigiúnacha nó náisiúnta. Ina measc bhí ceolchoirmeacha, taispeántais, comhdhálacha, léachtaí, scannáin, drámaí agus taibhithe eile. Chuir an dá Chomhairle 24% de na himeachtaí ar fáil, Chuir comhpháirtithe áitiúla 41% ar fáil, 14% i gceantair eile agus chuir eagraíochtaí náisiúnta 21% de na himeachtaí ar fáil.

Soláthraíodh thart ar 80 imeacht ar líne mar fhreagairt ar shrianta COVID-19. Tugadh deis, mar sin, imeachtaí ceiliúrtha a chur ar fáil do lucht féachana idirnáisiúnta, chomh maith leis sin, tugadh an deis do lucht féachana áitiúil páirt a ghlacadh in imeachtaí i gceantair eile. Tharla an líon is mó imeachtaí ar dhá ócáid thábhachtach - Lá Fhéile an Naoimh ar an 9 Meitheamh 2021 agus ar a bhreithlá cothrom an lae sin 1500 bliain ó shin ar an 7 Nollaig 2021.

Bhí dhá phríomhimeacht ag deireadh na bliana sin a d'eagraigh Comhairle Contae Dhún na nGall. Ar an 6 Nollaig 2021 thug imeacht idirnáisiúnta ar líne *Cholmcille 1500: A Journey Through Ireland & Scotland* suíomhanna le chéile a raibh nasc acu le Colmcille trí ghearrscannáin agus trí dhíospóireacht phainéil ar fhreastail 140 duine as 10 tír orthu. Rinne Comhairle Contae Dhún na nGall cuid de na gearrscannáin seo a choimisiúnú chomh maith le léarscáil mhaisithe de shuíomhanna in Éirinn agus in Albain i nGaeilge agus i nGaeilge na hAlban i gcomhar le Rannóg na Gaeilge agus le tacaíocht ó Foras na Gaeilge.

Bhí an imeacht deiridh ar an 7 Nollaig 2021 in Ionad Oidhreacht Cholmcille lena bhreithlá a chomórath san áit ar rugadh é. Labhair Cathaoirleach Chomhairle Contae Dhún na nGall agus Méara Chathair Dhoire agus Chomhairle Ceantair an tSraitha Báin chomh maith le ceannairí eaglaise le lucht freastail na hócáide trasteorann seo. Áiríodh ann an chéad taibhiú de bheochaintí a cruthaíodh trí Thionscadal Béaloidis na Scoileanna Digiteacha agus ina dhiaidh sin nochtadh dealbh ealaíne poiblí de Cholmcille ar an N56 in aice le Cill Mhic Réanáin. Bhí íomhánna digiteacha á dteilgean fosta i nGartán agus i nDoire mar chuid de thionscadal soilsithe de *Coinneal Cholmcille* ar fud na hÉireann agus na hAlban.

Colmcille 1500 Events

Over 150 events took place during 2021 by local, regional or national partners. These included concerts, exhibitions, conferences, lectures, films, plays and other performances. 24% of events were delivered by the two Councils, 41% by local partners, 14% in other areas and 21% by national organisations.

Approximately 80 events were delivered online in response to COVID-19 restrictions. This provided an opportunity to bring celebrations to an international audience as well as enabling local audiences to participate in events in other areas. The largest number of events took place around two key milestones for the year - the Saint's Feast Day on 9th June 2021 and his 1500th birthday on 7th December 2021.

The year culminated in two key events organised by Donegal County Council. On 6th December 2021 an international online event *Colmcille 1500: A Journey Through Ireland & Scotland* brought together locations with a connection to Colmcille through short films and panel discussions attended by 140 people across 10 countries. Donegal County Council commissioned a number of these short films in collaboration with Rannóg na Gaeilge and supported by Foras na Gaeilge as well as an Illustrated map of sites in Ireland and Scotland in Irish, English and Scottish Gaelic.

On 7th December 2021 a closing event took place at the Colmcille Heritage Centre to mark the Saint's birthday at his birthplace. This cross-border event was addressed by An Cathaoirleach of Donegal County Council and the Mayor of Derry City and Strabane District Council as well as church leaders. It included the premiere of animations created through the Digital Schools Folklore Project and was followed by an unveiling of the N56 Colmcille public art sculpture near Kilmacrennan. Digital images were also projected in Gartán and Derry as part of *Coinneal Cholmcille* illuminations project across Ireland and Scotland.

Tionscnaimh Colmcille 1500 faoi stiúir na Comhairle

Rinne an Chomhairle an-chuid tionscadal de chuid Colmcille 1500 a threorú agus a choimisiúnú agus chuir sí an-chuid tacaíochta ar fáil le linn na bliana. Fuair na tionscadail seo a leanas tacaíocht ó réimse maoinitheoirí, ina measc, bhí Ciste Forbartha an Iarthuaiscirt, Éire Ildánach, an Chomhairle Oidhreachta, an Chomhairle Ealaíon, Bonneagar Iompair Éireann agus an Roinn Turasóireachta, Cultúir, Ealaíon, Gaeltachta, Spóirt agus Meán.

Council-led Colmcille 1500 Initiatives

Donegal County Council has led, commissioned or supported a large number of Colmcille 1500 projects for the year. Colmcille 1500 Grant Scheme

The *Colmcille 1500* Grants Scheme provided an opportunity for local communities to engage and contribute to 1500th commemorations. It was supported by the North West Development Fund and Creative Ireland with grants of €2,000 awarded to 18 organisations across Donegal and Derry. The projects covered a range of themes including history, music, drama, literature, art, archaeology, spirituality and folklore.

Marketing

Funding from the North West Development Fund enabled the marketing of the overall *Colmcille 1500* programme through the creation of a dedicated website at www.colmcille1500.com and social media platforms. The programme co-ordinated 10 marketing campaigns throughout the year as well as 320 posts on www.facebook.com/Colmcille1500NW.

Legacy

A significant number of legacy resources have been created during *Colmcille 1500* such as short films, animations, publications, virtual trails, audio guides as well as new music and art commissions. The dedicated website will provide a central platform for these as well as online recordings of events throughout the year. The Programme has also supported the development of legacy projects such as the Slí Cholmcille Camino which is seeking to establish a pilgrimage and walking route linking key sites related to Colmcille.

Decade of Centenaries

In 2021 the Culture Division, Donegal County Council delivered a series of engaging and informative projects exploring the history of the Decade of Centenaries in County Donegal. The projects were supported by the Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sport and Media under the Decade of Centenaries 2012-2023 Initiative. The Culture Division has commemorated the Decade of Centenaries with exhibitions, publications, activities and events since 2012. The events of the Decade are of particular resonance in Donegal, from the First World War when hundreds of young men from every part of the County lost their lives, to the impact of Partition which is still felt in many aspects of life up to the present day. The projects delivered in 2021 were as follows:

Iniúchadh ar Chuimhneacháin

Choimisiúnaigh Músaem Contae Dhún na nGall agus an Oifig Oidhreachta MacConmara Heritage Consulting chun tabhairt faoi iniúchadh ar chuimhneacháin a bhaineann leis na Deich mBliana de Chomórach an Chéid 1919-1923 agus a raibh rochtain phoiblí orthu. Thug siad faoi phróiseas comhairliúcháin phoiblí chomh maith le taighde domhain a raibh iniúchadh cuimsitheach mar thoradh air lena n-áirítear tuarascáil agus bunachar sonraí. Áiríodh sa tionscadal cuimhneacháin a bhain le Cogadh na Saoirse, le Cogadh na gCarad agus leis an Chéad Chogadh Domhanda. Aithníodh 81 cuimhneachán éagsúil.

Bordering Realities - Tionscadal Beochaintí

Mar chuid den tionscadal trasteorann *Bordering Realities* faoi stiúir Chomhairle Contae Mhuineacháin, coimisiúnaíodh *Rezolve Media* chun 5 scannán bheochana a sholáthar, ag plé le scéalta le linn Chogadh na Saoirse ó réigiúin na teorann i nDún na nGall, Muineachán, Doire, Ard Mhacha agus Fear Manach. Beidh an tionscadal seo ar siúl thar thréimhse 3 bliana.

Artist in Residence

Margaret Hannon was commissioned to work with the County Archives and Donegal County Museum as Artist in Residence to create new artistic work in response to their collections of material from the period 1919-1923. Margaret is an actor, writer and theatre maker. The result of her residency is a drama, *One People*, which tells the story of a grieving woman who has a series of encounters with ghosts from the Decade of Centenaries who challenge her preconceptions of the past. The drama involved a small cast of local actors and was performed in the Museum in November.

Audit of Memorials

Donegal County Museum and the Heritage Office commissioned MacConmara Heritage Consulting to undertake an audit of publicly accessible memorials relating to the Decade of Centenaries 1919-1923. They undertook a public consultation process as well as in-depth research which resulted in a comprehensive audit including a report and database. The project included memorials relating to the War of Independence, Civil War and World War I. 81 different memorials were identified.

Bordering Realities – Animation Project

Rezolve Media were commissioned to deliver 5 animated films, exploring stories during the War of Independence from the border regions of Donegal, Monaghan, Derry, Armagh and Fermanagh as part of the *Bordering Realities* cross-border project led by Monaghan County Council. This project will take place over a 3 year period.

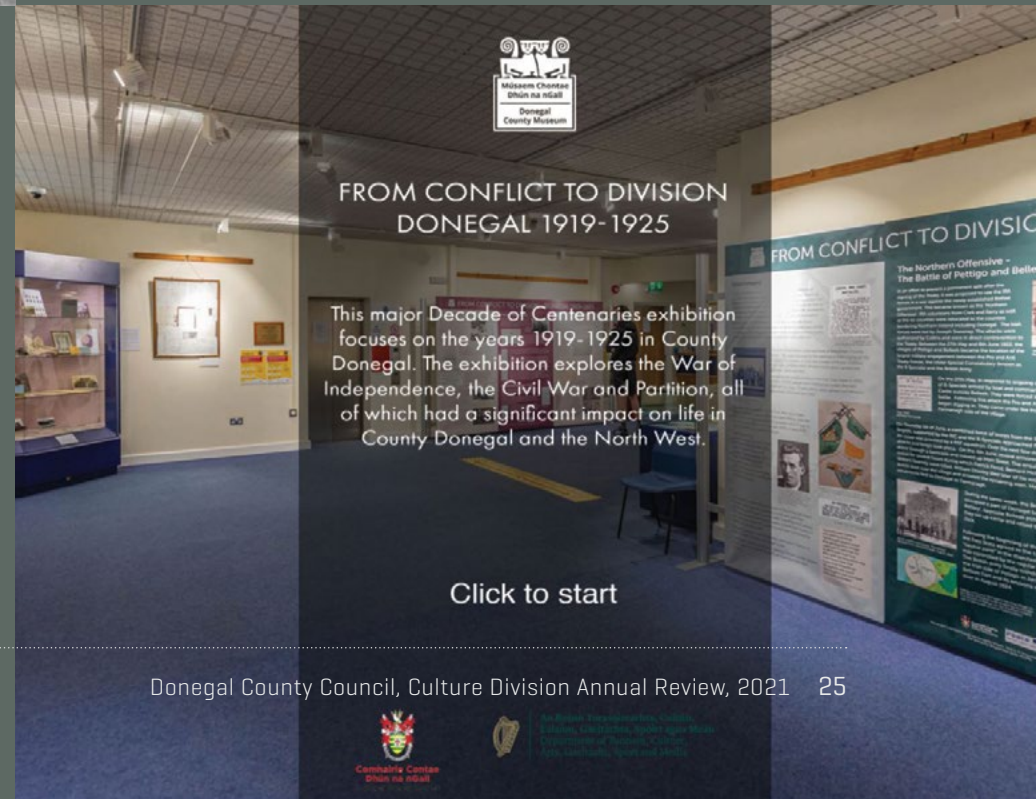

Oibríonn sí óna stiúideo ealaíontóra féin i mBaile Uí Leannáin, Baile Suingean. Is iad mná Dhún na nGall agus tithe Dhún na nGall, le linn na tréimhse 1919-1923, téama na bpictiúr. Tá *Legnathraw*, ola ar chanbhás, bunaithe ar sheanteach i mbaile fearainn beag Lag na Trá, taobh amuigh de Bhaile Suingean. Tá an pictiúr suite sa Samhradh. Tá *Meenagrauv*, ola ar chanbhás, bunaithe ar sheanteachín i mbaile fearainn Míin na gCnámh taobh amuigh de Shraith an Urláir. Tá an pictiúr suite sa Gheimhreadh.

Turas Fíorúil ar an Taispeántas – Ó Choimhlint go Deighilt, Dún na nGall 1919-1925

D’oibrigh Músaem Chontae Dhún na nGall le Paul Marshall ó Visual Arts Media chun turas fíorúil a fhorbairt ar an taispeántas *Ó Choimhlint go Deighilt, Dún na nGall 1919-1925*. Cuimsíonn sé seo turas 360 céim ar an taispeántas le cumas súmáil isteach ar gach painéal taispeántais agus ar roinnt déantán roghnaithe sa taispeántas. Beidh an turas fíorúil ar fáil trí shuíomh gréasáin na Comhairle in 2022.

Historian in Residence

Dr Ben Rogers was commissioned to work with the County Archives as historian in residence. He carried out research on two of the County Archives Collections, the Joseph Murray Collection and selected Rural & Urban District Council minute books from 1918 – 1925. The outcome of the research is six publishable essays and a series of online talks.

Open Call to Artists

Ann Quinn was commissioned to create two paintings reflecting on aspects of life in Donegal during the period 1919-1923. In 2020 Ann received an Artist Bursary Award from the Arts Council of Ireland and has previously exhibited in galleries throughout Ireland and at the RHA Annual Exhibition every year since 2004. She works from her own artist’s studio at Ballylennan, St. Johnston. The theme of the paintings is Donegal women and Donegal homes, during the period 1919-1923. *Legnathraw*, oil on canvas, is based on an old house in the small townland of Legnathraw, outside St. Johnston. The painting is set in Summer. *Meenagrauv*, oil on canvas, is based on an old cottage in the townland of Meenagrauv outside Stranorlar. The painting is set in Winter.

Virtual Tour of the Exhibition – From Conflict to Division Donegal 1919-1925

Donegal County Museum worked with Paul Marshall of Visual Arts Media to develop a virtual tour of the exhibition *From Conflict to Division, Donegal 1919-1925*. This includes a 360 degree tour of the exhibition with the ability to zoom in on each exhibition panel as well as on a select number of artefacts in the exhibition. The virtual tour will be available through the Council website in 2022.

Wainfest Children's Arts and Book Festival

In October, during *Wainfest*, the Library Service organised a number of events under the theme of the Decade of Centenaries. These included talks by authors Ann Murtagh and Brian Gallagher and historians Liz Gillis and Ida Milne. There were educational live online presentations by John D Ruddy, Creator of the YouTube history series *Manny Man Does History* and by Michael Moylan of Irish History Live. 1496 pupils participated in the Decade of Centenaries school events during *Wainfest*.

WWI Database based on the County Donegal Book of Honour

The Museum, working with the Information Systems Section of the Council, developed an online database containing all the listings published in the County Donegal Book of Honour, The Great War 1914-1918. The searchable database contains information on each person from Donegal who died as a result of the War including, name, service number and place of birth. Seirbhís Leabharlainne

Cuireann Seirbhís Leabharlainne Dhún na nGall rochtain ar fáil ar líonra náisiúnta de níos mó ná 333 leabharlann agus ar níos mó ná 15 milliún earra stoic, chomh maith le bailiúchán náisiúnta de ríomhleabhair agus leabhair ríomh-chlosamhairc, nuachtáin ar líne, irisí, ábhar tagartha, cúrsaí teanga agus cúrsaí foghlama.

Le linn 2021, lean an tSeirbhís Leabharlainne uirthi ag déanamh oiriúnú ar an dóigh ar sholáthair sí seirbhísí chun treoir an Rialtais a chur san áireamh maidir leis na leibhéil éagsúla srianta mar thoradh ar phaindéim COVID -19. Ag leibhéil éagsúla chuir muid ar fáil: Seirbhísí Seachadta ar Leac an Dorais, Teagmháil agus Bailigh, Brabhsáil agus Iasacht lena n-áirítear úsáid ríomhairí, Wi-Fi agus áiseanna staidéir; chomh maith le leanúint ar aghaidh ag tairiscint, ag cur chun cinn agus ag leathnú na seirbhísí a chuirimid ar fáil ar líne – lena n-áirítear acmhainní breise ar líne agus an clár imeachtaí ar líne a leathnú.

Chonaic an tSeirbhís Leabharlainne fás leanúnach ollmhór in úsáid acmhainní ar líne i rith na bliana, agus tháinig méadú breis is 57% ar úsáid ríomh-chlosleabhar amháin idir 2020 agus 2021.

Library Service

Donegal Library Service provides access to a national network of over 333 libraries and over 15 million items of stock as well as a national collection of e-books and e-audio books, online newspapers, magazines, reference material, language and learning courses.

During 2021, the Library Service continued to adapt the way it delivered services to take account of Government guidance for the different levels of restrictions as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. At various levels we provided: Doorstep Delivery Services, Contact and Collect, Browse and Borrow including computer use, WiFi and study facilities; as well as continuing to offer, promote and extend the services we offered online – including additional online resources and expanding the online events programme.

The Library Service continued to see a huge growth in the use of online resources throughout the year, with the use of e-audio books alone growing by over 57% between 2020 and 2021.

Seachtain na Gaeilge

The Irish language festival was launched online on the 26th of February. The launch was followed by an online concert with Caitlín Nic Gabhainn and Ciarán Ó Maonaigh. The festival which ran until the 21st of March, had a full programme including storytelling, read and discuss sessions, cookery demonstrations, singing and photography competitions as well as poetry readings and conversation groups. Almost 4,000 people attended the online library events during the two weeks of the festival.

Library Staff Skills Development

Throughout the year, library staff undertook a wide and varied online training programme organised by the Libraries Development Unit, LGMA. The training programme ranged from Social Media and Online Library Promotion to Facilitating and Mediating Online Events to Leadership and Communications Skills.

Right to Read Programme

Donegal Library Service, with partner organisations, draws up and coordinates an annual local *Right to Read Action Plan* and works with those partners towards its implementation.

Some highlights of 2021 are listed below.

Read DL 2021

The book selected for Read DL 2021 was *Brilliant*, by Irish author Roddy Doyle. The book focused on the theme of well-being. Eleven online events took place, with three additional online recordings compiled by a local school adding to the programme. An estimated 16,790 children and young people attended these online events through their schools. Roddy Doyle was interviewed for the grand finale by local interviewers Evie O'Donnell and Jack Myers.

Read DL is an action of the Donegal CYPSC Plan and Donegal Right to Read plan, and is run in partnership between Donegal ETB, the Library Service, LYIT, School Completion Programme (SCP) and Home School Community Liaison (HSCL).

First 5 Little Library Initiative

First 5 Little Library is a nationwide collaboration between the Department of Children, Equality, Disability, Integration and Youth (DCEDIY), the Department of Rural and Community Development (DRCD) and the Local Government Management Agency (LGMA).

Donegal Libraries liaised with local Early Learning and Care (ELC) settings, After-schools and child-minders during April and November 2021 to distribute free book bags and an opportunity to register for library membership as part of the *First 5 Little Library* initiative.

Chuir ár Seirbhís leabharlainne 446 mála *Leabharlann Bheag* ar fáil do sholáthraithe áitiúla cúram leanaí le málaí breise ar fáil le tabhairt ar iasacht ón líonra leabharlainne.

Wainfest: Féile Ealaíon agus Leabhar do Pháistí

Bhí *Wainfest* ar siúl ón 2 go dtí an 10 Deireadh Fómhair. Tá an fhéile ríthábhachtach chun tacú le forbairt litearthachta do leanaí agus dá dteaghlaigh ar fud Chontae Dhún na nGall. Mar chuid de chur chuige comhordaithe agus inbhuanaithe go háitiúil, chinntigh an clár leathan ildánach go raibh rud éigin ann do gach duine. Reáchtáladh 104 imeacht san iomlán le linn na féile a mhair seachtain. Ghlac 13,387 duine ar fad páirt in *Wainfest* i mbliana. Tá tuilleadh eolais ar an fhéile ar fáil ag www.wainfest.ie.

Cláir eile a bhaineann leis an Cheart Chun Léitheoireachta

Reáchtáil an tSeirbhís leabharlainne imeachtaí i rith na bliana mar chuid de *Scéalaíocht an Earraigh*, *Eachtraíocht Léitheoireachta Réalta an tSamhraidh*, *Seachtain na hEolaíochta* agus *Am Teaghlaigh i do Leabharlann Áitiúil*.

Under this initiative more than 4,500 early learning and care settings nationally were invited to collect free book bags and other resources from their local library. The aim was to encourage a love of books and reading among young children, and increased collaboration between libraries and ELCs. The Little Library included a number of books and other resources, including our own locally produced *Babbling Babies: multilingual nursery rhyme and action song book* which was developed with CYPSC partners here in Donegal. Our Library Service made available 446 *Little Library* bags to local childcare providers with additional bags available for borrowing from the library network.

Wainfest, Children's Arts and Book Festival

Wainfest ran from the 2nd to the 10th October. The festival is key to supporting literacy development for children and their families across County Donegal. As part of a locally coordinated and sustainable approach, the hybrid and versatile line-up ensured there was something for everyone. A total of 104 events were held during the week-long festival. Total participation for *Wainfest* this year was 13,387. More information on the festival is available at www.wainfest.ie.

Other Right to Read Programmes

Throughout the year the Library Service held events as part of *Spring into Storytime*, *Summer Stars Reading Adventure*, *Science Week* and *Family Time at Your Library*.

Feachtas ‘Go dTé Tú Slán’

Ina theannta sin, d’oibrigh an tSeirbhís Leabharlainne i gcomhar leis an Chomhaontas ar son Daoine Níos Sine leis an ealaíontóir cáiliúil as Dún na nGall, Ann Quinn, chun sraith ceardlann sheachtainiúil ealaíne ar líne a chur i láthair do dhaoine aosta agus do dhaoine faoi mhíchumas. Bhí na ranganna ealaíne ar siúl ar líne thar thréimhse 5 seachtaine. Mhair na ranganna uair an chloig le huasmhéid de 6 rannpháirtí in aghaidh an ghrúpa. Ba *Home and Place* téama na gceardlann. Choimhéad rannpháirtithe ar Ann ag péinteáil ina stiúideo agus iad i mbun a gcuid ealaíne féin. Chomh maith leis na buntáistí teiripeacha a bhaineann le péintéireacht bhí gné shóisialta leis na ranganna agus dhéanadh Ann comhrá leis na rannpháirtithe agus chuir sí aithne orthu thar an tréimhse 5 seachtaine.

I measc na gcainteoirí bhí an Dr Mary O’Kane (féinmheas a thógáil), an Síceolaí Louise Shanagher (aireachas cruthaitheach), an Dr Malie Coyne (ag tacú le déagóirí imníocha), an Dr Catherine Riordan (aosú dearfach) agus an Dr Emma Yhnel (d’inchinn a choinneáil sláintiúil). Tá sé mar aidhm ag Éire Shláintiúil feachtas ar mheabhairshláinte, ar shláinte choirp agus ar bhia sláintiúil a chur chun cinn. Chomh maith le réimse imeachtaí a óstáil, soláthraíonn leabharlanna rochtain ar leabhair agus ar ríomhleabhair a bhaineann le sláinte.

Keep Well Campaign

53 Transition Year students from Donegal, under the guidance of facilitator Denise Blake, produced a wonderful book *Mute Unmute* as part of the Pobal CRF *Keep Well Campaign* during 2021. The students shared their thoughts on COVID-19 and their hopes and dreams for the future via a series of online workshops. The resulting book is thought-provoking and insightful, and available free of cost from the library service.

In addition, the Library Service in partnership with the Age Friendly Alliance, worked with renowned Donegal artist, Ann Quinn, to present a series of weekly online art workshops for older people and people with disabilities. The art classes took place online over a 5-week period. Classes lasted one hour with a maximum 6 participants per group. The theme of the workshops was *Home and Place*. The participants watched Ann paint in her studio while doing their own art. As well as the therapeutic benefits of painting there was a social aspect to the classes as Ann chatted and got to know the participants over the course of the 5 weeks.

Healthy Ireland at Your Library

22 online events were held as part of the *Healthy Ireland at Your Library* programme. Speakers included Dr Mary O’Kane (building self-esteem), Psychologist Louise Shanagher (creative mindfulness), Dr Malie Coyne (supporting anxious teens), Dr Catherine Riordan (positive ageing) and Dr Emma Yhnel (keep your brain healthy). Healthy Ireland aims to promote awareness of mental health, physical health and healthy eating. As well as hosting a range of events, libraries provide access to health-related books and eBooks.

An Tionscadal Tiontú Leathanaigh

Dormant Accounts Fund

Donegal Library Service was successful in getting 90% grant assistance approved from the Department of Rural and Community Development (Dormant Accounts Fund) to support measures set out in *Our Public Libraries 2022*. Donegal County Council provided 10% match-funding. The two projects approved for Donegal were:

Page Turner Project

The Library Service ran a hugely successful *Page Turner* Project from September to November 2021. A coordinator was commissioned to develop a plan, engage with DEIS schools and source experts in children's literature to deliver enjoyable, inspiring and engaging workshops to promote reading, literacy and library use. A total of 53 (50%) of DEIS primary schools registered for the project with 236 screens joining in for the 26 online workshops (4,476 participants). Six in-person workshops were also delivered to four schools as part of the project, with 525 participants attending.

Resources for Children with Down Syndrome

The Library Service received funding of €6,760 to provide access to two very useful resources for children with Down Syndrome. The resources, *See and Learn* and *Numicon*, are available in five libraries across the County. The Library Service worked with Down Syndrome Ireland on the selection of the resources. Plans are underway to rollout a programme of training to staff and users, in partnership with *Down Syndrome Donegal*.

Europe Direct Letterkenny

Europe Direct Letterkenny is based in Central Library, Letterkenny and has a satellite centre in Leabharlann Phobail Ghaoth Dobhair. Its objective is to promote easy access to information about the EU, and to stimulate discussion and debate through information provision and events. This year's highlights included the Centre's re-launch by the Cathaoirleach of Donegal County Council, Councillor Jack Murray and special guest Maria Walsh MEP, the regional heats of the *Soap Box Competition* and the *Citizen Dialogues* with Transition Year students on the topics of Democracy and European Migration.

Colmille 1500

Colmille 1500

To commemorate the 1500th anniversary of the birth of Colmille in Gartan, County Donegal, the library service commissioned The Nerve Centre Creative Learning Centre (CLC) to work with primary schools on a digital folklore project, in partnership with library authorities in Sligo, Meath and Northern Ireland (Libraries NI.) Children from 20 primary schools, five from each authority, examined the Schools' Folklore Collection for stories relating to Colmille. The CLC worked closely with the designated teachers from each school, providing them training on how to create a digital animation with their class, from the initial idea, creating assets to animating and editing. All sessions took place online. The project culminated in an online showcase event on YouTube and a live launch of the Donegal project as part of the overall celebration on the birthday of Colmille, in the Colmille Heritage Centre in Gartan, on the 7th of December. As part of the project a graphic novel was also developed, and both the graphic novel and the digital animations can be viewed at <https://www.donegallibrary.ie/localfamilyhistory/>. The project was co-funded by Donegal County Council, Creative Ireland and the North West Development Fund.

The Library Service also presented a series of online lectures on the life and legacy of Saint Colmille. The lecture series, entitled *Books and Beyond*, provided engaging discussions and presentations from some of Ireland's best known Colmille experts. A Colmille bibliography was also developed providing details of all Colmille related books held in the library's Donegal Studies Collection.

Artists' Bursaries Scheme

The Council's Artists' Bursaries Scheme provided bursaries of up to €1,250 each to 47 of the county's leading professional visual artists, musicians, dramatists and writers. The bursaries provided support to enable them to sustain their practices while acknowledging the vital contribution they make to society and well-being.

Donegal Bay and Blue Stacks Festival

The 21st festival took place in October, marking a welcome return to live performances, albeit with considerable restrictions still in place. Among the highlights were Roseanne Lynch's drama, *Zandra Queen of Jazz* at the Abbey Arts Centre, on the extraordinary life and times of musician Alexandra Mitchell, late of Coolmore House, Rossnowlagh.

Further highlights included *The Bluestack Chorale's Songs for An Autumn Evening* with Deborah Cunningham, Paul Martin and Evan McGarrigle, at Donegal's St. Patrick's Parish Centre, and four new episodes of the popular drama series *Drumshee Days*, broadcast by *Dark Daughter Productions* on consecutive Fridays during the festival.

Oíche Chultúir

Culture Night

Culture Night took place on September 17th and in contrast to the 2020 event, it featured a predominantly live programme. A combined audience of 600 people safely enjoyed four performances of Inishowen Carnival Group’s Alchemist at Letterkenny Town Park, while Orson Sterritt’s Dr. Proctor entertained young audiences in a pop-up marquee at the Central Library.

The Museum’s *Colmcille-Man and Myth* exhibition opened to the public and the event was complemented by a Living History presentation of Donegal Womens Voices from The Past. The RCC was a hive of activity with up to 400 visitors enjoying artist Peadar McDaid’s curated *Portraits of Me* group show and the Turas series of exhibitions and installations.

Public Art

The Arts Service continued to advise and assist the Donegal Roads Office in the commissioning of public art works along the N56. Niall Bruton’s St. Colmcille-themed piece was installed at Kilmacrennan, while the commission for the third project on the route – that associated with the Mountcharles Inver realignment – was also awarded

In addition, Margaret Hannon's *Sister Black* enjoyed its first live audience performances, in Ballyshannon and Ramelton.

Local Live Performance Programme Support Schemes

The Arts Service and the Tourism Unit combined to deliver two phases of the Local Live Performance Programme Support Scheme in the county. A wide range of festivals and events were supported including a country music festival on Árainn Mhór, a weekend of performances and installations by Inishowen Carnival Group at Swan Park, Bunrana as part of the Derry Halloween Festival and a series of concerts at the Abbey Arts Centre with Na Mooneys and The Henry Girls.

An Grianán Theatre

An Grianán production of Brian Friel’s *The Enemy Within*, was its most ambitious to-date. Directed by Caitríona McLaughlin, a native of Carndonagh and Artistic Director of The Abbey Theatre, the play was a centrepiece of the Colmcille 1500 celebrations.

Another highlight was *Ré an tSolais – Mairéad Ní Mhaonaigh agus A Cairde*, recorded and broadcast as part of Letterkenny Trad Week in January and shown subsequently by TG4 on St. Patrick’s Day.

Supporting Donegal Artists to Create New Work

Much work was done supporting professional Donegal theatre artists such as Breandán de Gallaí, Little John Nee, Eve Li, Orson Sterritt, Tadhg Brennan, Patrick Quinn, Anwar Khan, Maggie Hannon, Shirley Anne Bonnar and Lorcan Strain, to create new work.

Similarly, the Little Acorns project encouraged new Donegal writers to submit scripts for online broadcast. Six of these were recorded in-house, using local professional actors and broadcast on Facebook. Another four were produced as radio dramas and heard on Highland Radio’s Nine ‘til Noon show.

An Grianán also took part in the Lasta initiative with the NASC Theatre Network, giving over their programming for two weeks to two young local artists, Fergal Lonergan and Ailís Cross-Gorman.

Taobh Amuigh den Amharclann

Ina ainneoin sin, chuir an fhéile breis agus 280 imeacht i láthair do lucht féachana de 36,000 agus lean sí ag obair le comhpháirtithe ar fud an chontae.

Clársceidealú ar líne

I measc na léirithe ar líne bhí cónaitheacht le The Henry Girls, an chéad léiriú de *Before*, saothar dátheangach le Pat Kinevane, agus sruth beo comhoibritheach le Féile Ealaíon Chairde Shligigh agus Amharclann Brokentalkers.

Pobal agus For-rochtain

Cé gur thug an phaindéim dúshlán, chuir sé deiseanna ar fáil fosta, agus mar thoradh air sin cuireadh béim ar a bheith ag obair le pobail nua agus ar úsáid bhreise a bhaint as spásanna lasmuigh. Mar sin, áiríodh ar an chlár an tionscadal *Big Telly’s Right Up Your Street* i mBaile Suingean, Ráth Bhoth agus Leitir Ceanainn, turais agus ceardlanna ar fud an chontae le *Fidget Feet Aerial Dance* agus *Tumblecircus* agus léiriú le comhlacht damhsa óg Bhreandán De Gallaí, Na Mic Ua gCorra, ar Oileán Thoraí.

Beyond The Auditorium

In response to Covid restrictions, the theatre opted on occasion to present work outside of the auditorium, with Fidget Feet Aerial Dance performing a vertical dance work against the back wall of the theatre, and the Gate Theatre’s *In Middle Town* being performed on a specially adapted truck in the theatre’s Car Park.

Earagail Arts Festival

The continuing Covid 19 pandemic led to a radical re-purposing of the programme towards a hybrid programme of online and live limited capacity events, while still maintaining support to Irish artists and increasing public engagement and diversity. Despite this, the festival presented over 280 events to a combined audience of 36,000 and continued to work with partners across the county.

Online Programming

Online performances included a residency by The Henry Girls, a premiere of Pat Kinevane’s bilingual production of *Before* and a collaborative live stream with Cairde Sligo Arts Festival and Brokentalkers Theatre.

Community and Outreach

While the pandemic brought challenges, it also provided opportunities, resulting in an emphasis on working with new communities and making additional use of outdoor spaces. As such, the programme included *Big Telly’s Right Up Your Street* project in St. Johnston, Raphoe and Letterkenny, tours and workshops across the county by *Fidget Feet Aerial Dance* and *Tumblecircus* and a performance by Breandán De Gallaí’s young dance company, Na Mic Ua gCorra, on Oileán Thoraigh.

Rialachas

To fully comply with the new Charities Governance Code, Earagail Arts Festival Management CLG undertook a major governance review throughout 2021, including a constitutional review, a review of the festival policies and procedures and board development.

The programme is made possible by annual funding from the Arts Council, Donegal County Council and project funding from a variety of sources.

Bringing Donegal Culture to a World Stage

COVID-19 restrictions during the first half of 2021 offered the RCC an exciting opportunity to continue building online audiences throughout the world and showcase the best of Donegal music and culture.

Letterkenny Trad Week took place online in January 2021 with a large selection of lunchtime and evening concerts, including a very special broadcast featuring newly commissioned music by Mairéad Ní Mhaonaigh and Altán.

St. Patrick's Day might have been quiet for most organisations in 2021 but the RCC took the celebrations online, on to the airwaves and on the TV screens. It produced shows for YouTube, Facebook, TG4 and Highland Radio. Guests included Brendan Quinn, Seamus McGuire, Steve Cooney, Tanya McCole, Altán, Megan Nic Ruairí, Sailor Bill, Irish dancing, and much more.

The North Texas Irish Music Festival, featuring leading Irish musical artists such as Donal Lunny and Andy Irvine, was streamed from the RCC in March. Over 22,000 Americans purchased digital tickets and spent the day enjoying the virtual show from Donegal, co-presented by the RCC and Donegal Diaspora Project.

Our online shows peaked in early June with *An Evening with Daniel O'Donnell and friends* receiving the most ever live streams for an online show produced in Ireland. This concert was filmed live from the RCC and raised much needed financial support for *Relay for Life Donegal*.

Nuálaíocht

In 2021, sheol an ICR *Gailearaithe gan Bhallaí*, clár comhoibritheach idir an Gallery of Photography Ireland, an tIonad Cultúrtha Réigiúnach, Leitir Ceanainn agus an Nerve Centre, Doire. D'éascaigh sé naisc thar an iliomad réimsí cruthaitheacha, ag ligint d'ealaíontóirí triail a bhaint as formáidí nuálacha úra chun saothar a chur i láthair.

Sa chéad leagan seo de *Gailearaithe gan Bhallaí*, rinne cúigear ealaíontóirí lionsa-bhunaithe agus cúigear cumadóirí fuaime iniúchadh ar shaol NFTanna, rinne siad athshamhlú ar chomhlachtaí reatha oibre chun scaipeadh ar líne, agus d'fhorbair siad saothair ealaíne digiteacha nua i gcomhar le chéile a léiríodh ar líne agus go pearsanta san Ionad Cultúrtha Réigiúnach. Ba é an taispeántas NFT seo an chéad cheann dá leithéid san Eoraip agus réitigh sé an bealach d'institiúidí ealaíne ceannródaíocha i Londain, i bPáras, i mBeirlín agus i mBaile Átha Cliath.

Na hAmharc-Ealaíona

Tá ceann de na dánlanna ciúb bán is fearr in Éirinn ag an ICR. Tá an polasaí taispeántais leathan agus dírithe d'aonghnó ar an lucht féachana agus éisteachta, agus is é an phríomhaidhm ná eispéiris ealaíon ar ardchaighdeán a thairiscint do dhaoine áitiúla agus do chuiditheoirí ar dóigh dóibh spéis a léiriú iontu. Tá an ICR tiomanta fosta do shaincheisteanna a bhfuil gné áitiúil agus níos leithne iontu a fhiosrú trí mheán an taispeántais. Léirítear an cur chuige comhthéacs-shonrach seo sa tiomantas do shaothar ardchaighdeán ó ealaíontóirí agus ó thionscadail ealaíne atá nasctha go háitiúil a choimisiúnú agus a thaispeáint, agus san éagsúlacht leathan meán agus disciplíní atá le feiceáil, lena n-áirítear ealaín chomhaimseartha, ceardaíocht, dearadh, ailtireacht, oideachas, stair shóisialta, míchumas agus sláinte. Déanann an tIonad taispeántais nua a choimeád agus a choimisiúnú agus roghnaíonn muid taispeántais chuairte agus tograí taispeántais atá ag teacht leis an fhealsúnacht seo atá dírithe ar an lucht féachana.

Innovation

In 2021, the RCC launched *Galleries Without Walls*. A collaborative programme by the Gallery of Photography Ireland, Regional Cultural Centre, Letterkenny and Nerve Centre, Derry. It facilitated connections across multiple creative fields, allowing artists to experiment with innovative new formats for presenting work.

In this first *Galleries Without Walls* iteration, five lens-based artists and five audio composers explored the world of NFTs, reimagined current bodies of work for online dissemination, and collaboratively developed new digital artworks that were exhibited both online and in-person at the Regional Cultural Centre. This NFT exhibition was the first of its kind in Europe and paved the way for leading art institutions in London, Paris, Berlin and Dublin.

Visual Arts

The RCC has one of the finest white cube galleries in Ireland. The exhibition policy is deliberately broad and audience centred and the main aim is to offer local people and visitors a variety of high quality arts experiences that are likely to be of interest to them. The RCC is also committed to exploring issues of local and wider interest through the medium of the exhibition. This context specific approach is manifested in a commitment to commissioning and showing high quality work from locally connected artists and art projects, and in the wide variety of media and disciplines featured, which includes contemporary art, craft, design, architecture, education, social history, disability, and health. The Centre curates and commissions new exhibitions and selects touring exhibitions and exhibition proposals that are consistent with this audience centred philosophy.

Chuir an ICR seónna an fhómhair i láthair go fisiciúil fosta leis an phéintéir tírdhreacha Ian Gordon agus an grianghrafadóir agus scríbhneoir Albanach Frank McElhinney.

Mol Cultúrtha

Lean an ICR ag obair go dlúth le healaíontóirí agus daoine cruthaitheacha éagsúla inár spásanna stiúideo i rith 2021. D'fhorbair ceoltóirí ar nós The Bonk, Junior Brother, Shammen Delly, Ryan Vail agus Peadar Coll saothar fuaimhe nua inár Stiúideo Fuaimhe. Chruthaigh ealaíontóirí ar nós Mantas Poderys, Macola Vonga, Charlie Joe Doherty agus Gabriel Blake mósáicí, pictiúir, ríomhírisí grianghrafadóireachta agus scannáin inár Stiúideo Ealaíne.

In 2021, the RCC worked with partners across Donegal to curate a multi-venue summer visual arts programme under the theme of *Turas / Journey*. This exhibition ran from June until August and explored the societal shifts that shape our collective identity. It featured mixture of leading Irish and Donegal artists presenting work in Letterkenny, Gartan, Bunrana and Gaoth Dobhair.

Artists included Celina Muldoon, Aideen Barry, Anthony Haughey, Sarah Lewtas, Ursula Burke, Cliodhna Timoney, Anaís Tondeu, Yesenia Thibault-Picazo, Bassam Al-Sabah, Sean Hillen, Frances Hegarty and Caoimghín Ó Fraithile.

The RCC also presented in-person autumn shows with landscape painter Ian Gordon and Scottish photographer and writer Frank McElhinney.

A Cultural Hub

The RCC continued to work closely with a variety of artists and creative people in our studio spaces throughout 2021. Musicians such as The Bonk, Junior Brother, Shammen Delly, Ryan Vail and Peadar Coll developed new audio work in our Sound Studio. Artists such as Mantas Poderys, Macola Vonga, Charlie Joe Doherty and Gabriel Blake created mosaics, paintings, photography zines and films in our Art Studio.

In 2021, d'fhorbair an Músaem taispeántas dar teideal, *Ó Chomhlínt go Deighilt, Dún na nGall 1919-1925*. Scrúdaíodh sa taispeántas imeachtaí Chogadh na Saoirse, an Chogaidh Chathartha agus na Críochdheighilte trí dhéantáin, cartlanna agus íomhánna, agus léirigh sé tionchar na mblianta réabhlóideacha ar mhuintir Dhún na nGall. Bhí an taispeántas seo mar chuid de Thionscadal Macallaí na nDeich mBliana a d'fhorbair Músaem Chontae Dhún na nGall agus Cartlann Chontae Dhún na nGall agus maoiníodh é trí *Chlár PEACE IV* atá á bhainistiú ag An Fhoras um Chláir Speisialta an AE [SEUPB].

Chuaigh an Músaem i gcomhpháirtíocht le hIonad Saorálaíochta Dhún na nGall chun comórtas grianghrafadóireachta a chur ar fáil a rinne ceiliúradh ar Obair Dheonach sa Phobal. Tugadh cuireadh do ghrianghrafadóirí amaitéaracha íomhánna d'oibríthe deonacha, agus iad i mbun oibre áit ar bith i gContae Dhún na nGall, a chur isteach. Bhí Gradam Cuimhneacháin John McDermott – Obair Dheonach i Réimse na hOidhreachta mar chuid den chomórtas, chun aitheantas a thabhairt don obair iontach a dhéanann oibríthe deonacha le músaeim, ionaid oidhreachta agus eagraíochtaí áitiúla ar son oidhreachta Chontae Dhún na nGall. Reáchtáladh an ócáid bhronnta duaiseanna i mí Mheán Fómhair sa Mhúsaem, áit a raibh na hiontrálacha ar taispeáint.

Chuaigh an Músaem i gcomhpháirtíocht fosta le hIonad Saorálaíochta Dhún na nGall chun an tionscadal *UnCover & ReDiscover Your Locality* a sholáthar. Moladh d'oibríthe deonacha eolas a fháil amach faoina n-oidhreachta áitiúil agus foilsíodh an méid a fuarthas i leabhrán tarraingteach. Museum Programme

In 2021, the Museum developed an exhibition entitled, *From Conflict To Division, Donegal 1919-1925*. The exhibition explored the events of the War of Independence, the Civil War and Partition through artefacts, archives and images and revealed the impact of the revolutionary years on the people of Donegal. This exhibition formed part of the Echoes of the Decade Project developed by Donegal County Museum and Donegal County Archives and was funded through the European Union's *PEACE IV Programme*, which is managed by the Special EU Programmes Body [SEUPB].

The Museum partnered with the Donegal Volunteer Centre to deliver a photographic competition which celebrated Volunteering in the Community. Amateur photographers were invited to submit images of volunteers at work anywhere within County Donegal. The competition included the Volunteering in Heritage- John McDermott Memorial Award, to recognise the extraordinary contribution that volunteers with local museums, heritage centres and organisations make to County Donegal's heritage. The prize giving event took place in September and the entries were displayed in an exhibition in the Museum.

The Museum also partnered with the Donegal Volunteer Centre to deliver the *UnCover & ReDiscover Your Locality* project. Volunteers were encouraged to find out about their local heritage and the submissions received were published in an attractive booklet. The booklet is available online at www.donegalcoco.ie/media/donegalcountyc/museum/UnCover%20%20ReDiscover%20Your%20Locality%20Booklet%20W.pdf and in hard copy, free of charge.

In November the Museum hosted an exhibition *Donegal femLENS* in conjunction with the Donegal Women's Network. The exhibition contained a series of documentary photography projects developed by women in Donegal, with topics including; Humans and Nature: Saving Seals, Women in Farming, MICA Homeowners Stories, Childhood Freedom, Loss, Living with

Maidir le *Músaem Anois Dé Domhnaigh* an 12 Meán Fómhair, thug an Coimeádaí turas ar an Mhúsaem inar nochtadh scéalta maidir le bailliúcháin agus foirgneamh an Mhúsaem. Le linn *Díche Chultúir*, d'óstáil an Músaem rogha beag píosaí gearrdhrámaíochta ar scéalta mhná Dhún na nGall le linn na tréimhse réabhlóidí, arna léiriú ag Maura Logue ó Dark Daughter Productions. Le linn na *Seachtaine um Chuimsiú Sóisialta* i mí Dheireadh Fómhair thug an Músaem agus Ionad Saorálaithe Dhún na nGall cuireadh d'iarrthóirí tearmainn i Leitir Ceanainn a bheith páirteach leo ar thuras treoraithe ar Leitir Ceanainn le Amanda Clarke, a chríochnaigh ag an Mhúsaem le turas ar na taispeántais. Thug Caroline Carr leagan ar líne dá cuid cainte *A Vanished World: The Landed Gentry of Donegal* to Sion Stables agus i mí na Samhna thug sí an chaint go pearsanta in Ardeaglais Cholm Naofa, Doire. Chuir Músaem an Chontae, An tSeirbhís Cartlainne agus na Seirbhísí Leabharlainne treoir ghinealais nua, Do Mhuintir ó Dhún na nGall, ar fáil ar líne ó shuíomhanna gréasáin an Mhúsaem, na Cartlainne agus na Leabharlainne.

I mí Iúil bhunaigh an Músaem líonra nua ina raibh ionadaithe ó mhúsaem áitiúla agus ó ionaid oidhreachta i nDún na nGall. Is é aidhm an líonra tacaíocht, comhairle agus foghlaim a sholáthar do na baill i réimsí chomh héagsúil le cúram, margáíocht, taispeántais agus deiseanna maoinithe.

Intracranial Hypertension, Lockdown Emergence, Stepping into the Flow and the lived experience of domestic abuse.

During the Bealtaine Festival the Museum hosted two online talks, *Untold; Donegal Women, the War of Independence and the Civil War* by Caroline Carr and *Tracing Pirates and their activities around Ireland's Atlantic Seaboard in the Early 17th Century* by Dr Connie Kelleher from the National Monuments Service. For *Museums Now* on Sunday 12th September, the Curator gave a tour of the Museum which revealed the stories of the Museum's collections and building. For *Culture Night*, the Museum hosted a small selection of short drama pieces on the stories of Donegal women during the revolutionary period, performed by Maura Logue of Dark Daughter Productions. During *Social Inclusion Week* in October the Museum and the Donegal Volunteer Centre invited asylum seekers in Letterkenny to join them on a guided tour of Letterkenny with Amanda Clarke, which ended at the Museum with a tour of the exhibitions. Caroline Carr gave an online version of her talk *A Vanished World: The Landed Gentry of Donegal* to Sion Stables and in November delivered the talk in person in St Columb's Cathedral, Derry. The County Museum, Archives and Library Services produced a new genealogy guide, *Your Donegal Family*, which is available online from the Museum, Archives and Library websites.

In July the Museum established a new network consisting of representatives from local museums and heritage centres in Donegal. The aim of the network is to provide support, advice and learning to the members in areas as diverse as collections care, marketing, exhibitions and funding opportunities.

Cholmcille 1500

I gcomhar le ceiliúradh *Cholmcille 1500*, d'fhorbair an Músaem taispeántas, *Colm Cille: An Fear agus an Miotas*, a osclaíodh ar Oíche Chultúir. Tá Naomh Colm Cille ar dhuine de na daoine is tábhachtaí sa Luath-Chríostaíocht a d'fhág oidhreacht ollmhór chultúrtha, stairiúil agus reiligiúnach ina dhiaidh. Thug an taispeántas cuairteoirí ar thuras eolais trí shaol Cholm Cille i nDún na nGall agus i nDoire agus rinne sé iarracht an fear a scaradh ón mhiotas. Bhí gnéithe ar leith ann a bhí fóirsteanach do theaghlaigh fosta ionas go bhféadfadh cuairteoirí idir óg agus aosta na scéalta a bhaineann leis an naomh a iniúchadh. Táirgeadh leabhrán saor in aisce agus turas fíorúil ar an taispeántas fosta. Comhthionscadal a bhí sa taispeántas idir Comhairle Contae Dhún na nGall agus Comhairle Chathair Dhoire agus Cheantar an tSraitha Báin agus thacaigh an Roinn Turasóireachta, Cultúir, Ealaíon, Gaeltachta, Spóirt agus Meán leis.

Cholmcille 1500

In association with the *Colmcille 1500* celebrations, the Museum developed an exhibition, *Colmcille Man and Myths*, which opened on Culture Night. St Colmcille is one of the most important figures in early Christianity who left behind a huge cultural, historical and religious inheritance. The exhibition took visitors on a journey of discovery through Colmcille's life in Donegal and Derry and tried to separate the man from the myth. It also featured specific family friendly elements so that visitors both young and old could explore the stories associated with the saint. A free booklet and a virtual tour of the exhibition were also produced. The exhibition was a joint project between Donegal County Council and Derry City and Strabane District Council and was supported by the Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sport and Media.

Bhí scata beag aisteoirí áitiúla páirteach sa dráma agus léiríodh é sa Mhúsaem i mí na Samhna. Ag obair le Paul Marshall ó Visual Arts Media, d'fhorbair an Músaem turas fíorúil ar an taispeántas *Ó Choimhlint go Deighilt; Dún na nGall 1919-1925*. Beidh an turas fíorúil ar fáil trí láithreán gréasáin na Comhairle in 2022. D'oibrigh an Músaem fosta le Rannóg Córais Faisnéise na Comhairle chun bunachar sonraí ar líne a fhorbairt ina mbeidh na liostaí go léir a foilsíodh i *Leabhar Onóra Chontae Dhún na nGall, An Cogadh Mór 1914-1918* le faisnéis bhreise a ndearna an Músaem taighde air. Beidh rochtain ag an phobal ar an bhunachar sonraí in 2022.

Decade of Centenaries

The Museum continued its programme of activity to commemorate the Decade of Centenaries in 2021. Donegal County Museum, the Regional Cultural Centre and the Museum and Heritage Service of Derry City and Strabane District Council launched a series of six short video pieces *Women's Voices From The Past - Revolutionary Times* highlighting the experiences of women during the Revolutionary Period [1919-1923] <https://www.donegalcoco.ie/culture/decadeofcentenaries/>. The video pieces were produced by Dark Daughter Productions with videography by Oath Film Studio. The project was supported by the Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sport and Media under the Decade of Centenaries 2012-2023 initiative.

The Museum and Archives Service commissioned Margaret Hannon as Artist in Residence. The result of her residency was a drama, *One People*, which tells the story of a grieving woman who has a series of encounters with ghosts from the Decade of Centenaries who challenge her preconceptions of the past. The drama involved a small cast of local actors and was performed in the Museum in November. Working with Paul Marshall of Visual Arts Media the Museum developed a virtual tour of the exhibition *From Conflict to Division; Donegal 1919-1925*. The virtual tour will be available through the Council's website in 2022. The Museum also worked with the IS Section of the Council to develop an online database containing all the listings published in the *County Donegal Book of Honour, The Great War 1914-1918* with additional information researched by the Museum. The database will be publicly accessible in 2022.

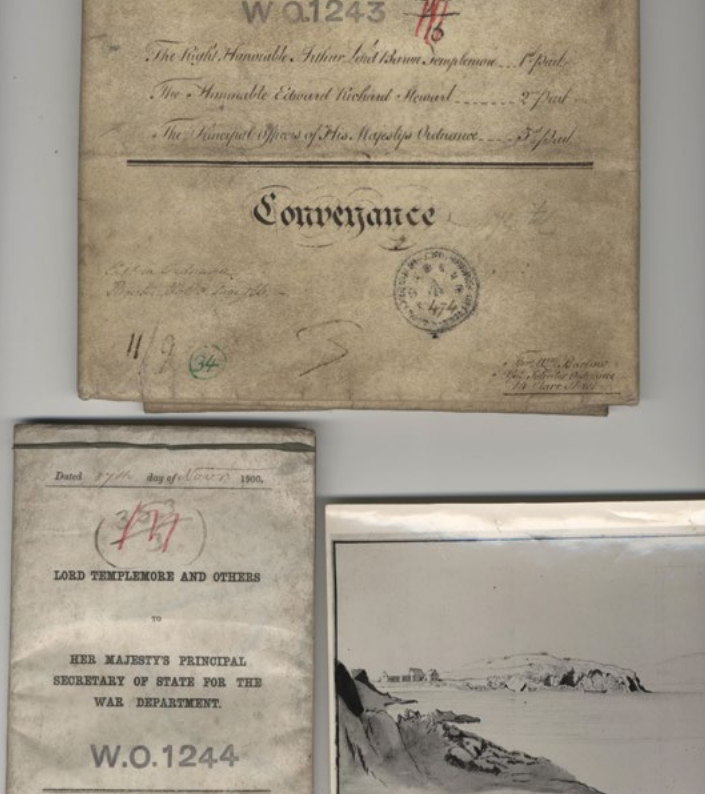

Decade of Centenaries

With funding from the Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sports and Media under the Community Strand of the 2021 Decade of Centenaries programme the Archives and Museum appointed a Historian in Residence Dr Ben Rogers of UCD. Dr Rogers researched archive collections including the *Rural and Urban District Councils*. He gave three lectures on political and social aspects of life in Co. Donegal in the revolutionary period. As part of the remit Dr Rogers also wrote a book of six essays [to be published early 2022]. The 2021 Decade of Centenaries Artist in Residence and Open Call Artist also utilized the resources of the Archives as part of their projects.

Peace IV: The Echoes of the Decade

Echoes of the Decade, the Archives and Museum Peace IV project under *Building Positive Relations* strand was finalized in April 2021. The project included engagement with young people on the broad theme of the history and legacy of Ireland's revolutionary years, 1912 – 1923. As part of the Echoes of the Decade project a professional oral historian, Regina Fitzpatrick, was contracted to carry out interviews with 13 individuals on the subject of the legacy of the decade of centenaries. Digitisation Projects

The minutes of the meetings of Ballyshannon Town Commissioners, the ten Rural District Councils [RDCs] and three Urban District Councils of Co. Donegal are part of the County Archives collection and are significant for the study of the Decade of Centenaries. Beyond 2022 Virtual Treasury

Donegal County Archives continued its partnership with *Beyond 2022*, the collaborative international digitisation and research project based in Trinity College Dublin. The project’s aim is to create a virtual reconstruction of the Public Records Office which was destroyed in the early days of the Civil War in 1922. The Archivist and other members of the Local Government Archivists & Records Managers group [LGARM] collaborated with *Beyond 2022* in the publication, *People, Place and Power*, which outlined the history and archives of *Ireland’s Grand Jury*; and in delivering and speaking at a conference commemorating the centenary of the burning of the Custom House in May 1921. The conference showcased a number of informational videos including one on Donegal County Archives’ Grand Jury records; it can be viewed at www.youtube.com/watch?v=5csuCtgQFY8.

Colmille: A Life and Legacy Education Pack

As part of the Colmille 1500 commemoration programme, the Archives Service commissioned a new primary school pack from Abarta Heritage. The pack *Colmille: A Life and Legacy/Beatha agus Oidhreacht Cholm Cille Pacáiste Oideachais* was co-funded by Donegal County Council and Creative Ireland. It includes an illustrated booklet which gives an overview of Colmille’s life and legacy; and thirteen worksheets and exercises. The pack is intended generally for children aged from 7 to 12.

With the cooperation and help of the Library Service and the Donegal Education Centre, the pack was rolled out to primary school teachers and students across Co. Donegal and in Sligo, Derry and Meath. Irish and English language versions are also available to view and download on our website: www.donegalcoco.ie/culture/archives/education/.

Collections and Records Management

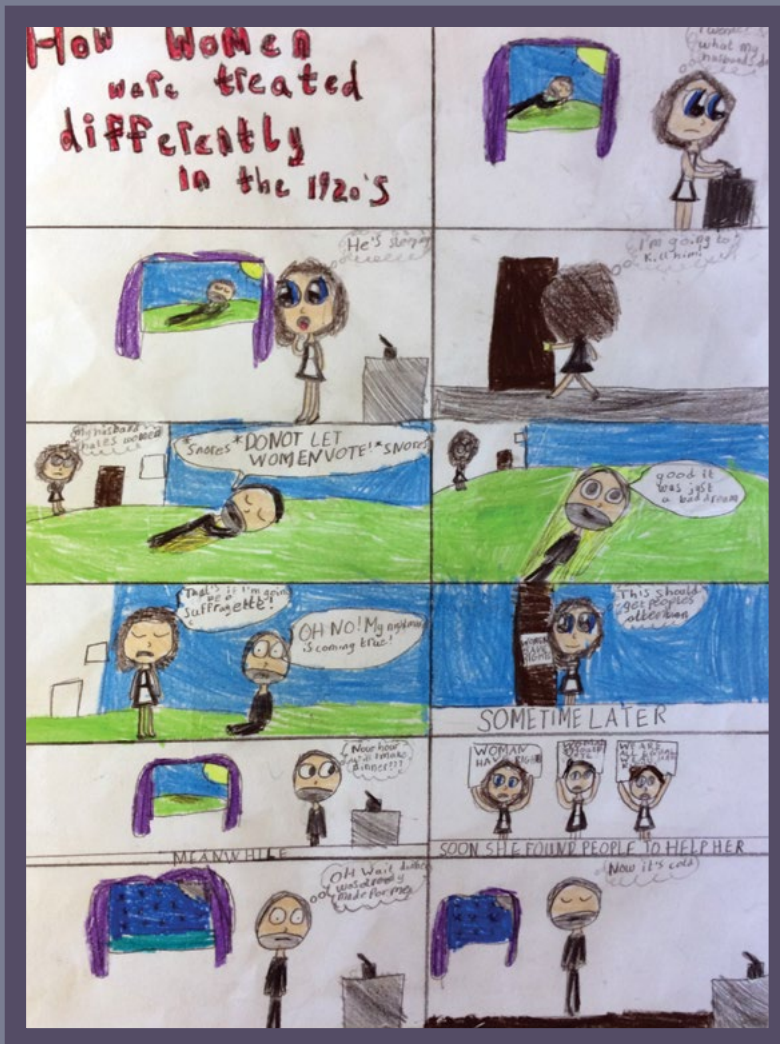
Among the acquisitions in 2021 were records from Donagh, Malin, Inch Island, Ardcrone, Boyagh and Castleshanaghan National Schools; a final tranche of Bunrana Urban District Council Archive; and two substantial collections relating to political, social and family history in early to mid-twentieth century Co. Donegal.

Among the collections catalogued in 2021 were the William Walker and John Cuthbertson [Downings pier] archive, legal deeds relating to Inch Fort [1810 – 1900], C J O’Sullivan shop in Mountcharles, railway records and photographs, and a number of school records as well as Ballyshannon Town Commissioners.

A detailed survey took place of the archives repository in Lifford. The Bunrana Urban District Council records were surveyed in Bunrana, transferred to Archives and box listed.

Local Government Archivists & Records Managers Group

The Archivist continued as Chair of the LGARM and collaborated with other local archivists, The Heritage Council, the National Archives, the LGMA, Trinity College Dublin, Fórsa, ARA & other bodies on various projects and issues including *Beyond 2022*, the Government’s Report of the Government Commission of Investigation into Mothers and Baby Homes, the Revision of the National Records Retention Policy for Local Authorities, the Anglo-Irish Treaty Centenary Exhibition and *History Ireland*.

Heritage Office

The role of the County Donegal Heritage Office is to raise awareness, provide advice, collect data, develop policy and promote best practice in relation to our cultural, built and natural heritage. It oversees the implementation of the County Heritage Plan in partnership with the County Heritage Forum. The Heritage Officer Programme is a partnership between The Heritage Council and local authorities and the highly successful programme was independently reviewed in 2021.

Thacaigh an tionscnamh le hoibreacha caomhnaithe a dhéanamh ar 12 réadmhaoin stairiúla feadh an Mheal agus ceann ar an Phríomhshráid Uachtarach lenar áiríodh deisiúcháin dín agus simléir, suiteáil earraí uisce báistí déanta as iarann teilgthe, fuinneoga agus doirse sais adhmaid a athbhunú, rindreáil aoil a chur i bhfeidhm, fásra a bhaint agus aghaidheanna siopaí traidisiúnta a dheisiú. I dtionscadal réimse poiblí cruthaitheach eile a bhí bainte leis, agus a maoiníodh faoin chlár Éire Ildánach, cuireadh comharthaíocht thraidisiúnta lámhphéinteáilte ar ais, cruthaíodh múrmhaisiú ar bhinn tí, agus cuireadh maisiú sealadach ar thrí aghaidh siopaí folmha feadh an Mheal. Cuireadh taithí Thionscnamh Bailte Stairiúla Ráth Mealtain ó 2020 i láthair ag ceardlann náisiúnta Thionscnamh na mBailte Stairiúla i mí Eanáir. Mar chuid d'Óíche Chultúir i mí Mheán Fómhair, nocht Ceathrú Ardeaglais Leitir Ceanainn i gcomhar le Comhairle Contae Dhún na nGall plaic chun comóradh a dhéanamh ar *Ghradam Ardmholadh Uachtarán Institiúid Pleanála na hÉireann do Thionscnamh Bailte Stairiúla Lána* na hEaglaise.

Historic Towns Initiatives

Donegal County Council's application for a Ballyshannon Historic Towns Initiative was successful and was awarded €237,700 in funding from The Heritage Council and the Department of Housing, Local Government & Heritage. The initiative was prepared and managed by the Heritage Officer and the Conservation Officer in partnership with the Ballyshannon Regeneration Group, Dedalus Architecture and local owners and residents. The initiative supported conservation works to 12 historic properties along The Mall and one on Upper Main Street that included roof and chimney repairs, installation of cast-iron rainwater goods, reinstatement of timber sash windows and doors, application of lime render, removal of vegetation and the repair of traditional shopfronts. An associated creative public realm project funded under the Creative Ireland programme saw the reinstatement of traditional hand-painted signage, the creation of a gable mural and the meanwhile use of three vacant shopfronts along The Mall. The Ramelton Historic Towns Initiative experience from 2020 was presented at the Historic Towns Initiative national workshop in January. As part of *Culture Night* in September, the Letterkenny Cathedral Quarter in conjunction with Donegal County Council unveiled a plaque commemorating the *Irish Planning Institute's President's Highly Commended Award* for the Church Lane Historic Towns Initiative.

Comórthaí Colmcille 1500

Mar chuid de chur i bhfeidhm Phlean Oidhreachta Chontae Dhún na nGall, chuir an Oifig Oidhreachta leabhar dathúcháin 36-leathanach saor in aisce ar fáil dar teideal *Léargas ar Cholm Cille* ag cur béime ar chuid de na suíomhanna oidhreachta, áiteanna, réada agus ábhair chartlainne a bhaineann le gnéithe de shaol agus d'oidhreacht Cholm Cille. Chomh maith leis sin, choimisiúnaigh an Oifig Oidhreachta treoir fuaime dátheangach ar *Dhún na nGall Cholm Cille*, sheol muid turas fíorúil 3D ar Thuras Cholm Cille i nGleann Cholm Cille agus thacaigh muid le Colmcille 1500 – *Man, Myth, Memory, Scoil Scairte History Ireland* i mí na Samhna. I gcomhpháirtíocht leis an Stiúrthóireacht Bóithre agus Iompair agus le tacaíocht ó Chiste Forbartha an Iarthuaiscirt, críochnaíodh oibreacha caomhnaithe ar Mhainistir Chill Mhic Réanáin agus ar Shéipéal Cholm Cille i nGartán. Is séadchomharthaí seandálaíochta iad an dá struchtúr seo atá faoi chosaint faoi Achtanna na Séadchomharthaí Náisiúnta [1930-2004] agus tá siad faoi chaomhnóireacht Chomhairle Contae Dhún na nGall.

Colmcille 1500 Commemorations

As part of the implementation of the County Donegal Heritage Plan, the Heritage Office produced a free, 36-page colouring book entitled *Illuminating Colmcille / Léargas ar Cholm Cille* highlighting some of the heritage sites, places, objects and archives associated with aspects of St. Colmcille's life and legacy. The Heritage Office also commissioned a bi-lingual audio guide on *St. Colmcille's Donegal / Dún na nGall Cholm Cille*, launched a 3D virtual tour of Turas Cholm Cille in Gleann Cholm Cille and supported the Colmcille 1500 – *Man, Myth, Memory History Ireland Hedge School* in Ballyshannon in November. In partnership with the Roads & Transportation Directorate and with support from the North West Development Fund, conservation works to Kilmacrennan Abbey and St. Colmcille's Chapel at Gartan were completed. Both of these structures are archaeological monuments protected under the National Monuments Acts [1930-2004] and are in the guardianship of Donegal County Council.

*Thacaigh Scéim Deontais Deisiúcháin Tuí, a bhfuil duaiseanna buaite aici, le 24 tionscadal deisiúcháin tuí. Bainistíonn an Oifig Oidhreachta agus an Oifig Caomhnaithe an scéim tras-stiúrthóireachta chun sainchomhairle a sholáthar d'úinéirí maidir le caomhnú tuí agus chun maoiniú a leithdháileadh ar dheisiúcháin tuí ar scála beag. Tharraing an scéim aird náisiúnta agus bhí sí le feiceáil ar nuacht RTÉ, BBC Radio Ulster, BBC Radio Foyle agus Newstalk Radio i mí an Mhárta. Thacaigh Ciste na Séadchomharthaí Pobail, arna riar ag an Roinn Tithíochta, Rialtas Áitiúil agus Oidhreachta i gcomhpháirtíocht leis an Oifig Oidhreachta agus leis an Oifig Chaomhnaithe, le tionscadail oidhreachta seandálaíochta ar fiú €223,500 iad ar an Dún i Loch an Dúin, iar-Eaglais Chill Mhic Réanáin, Eaglais Thobar Mhálanna, Daingean Uí Dhochartaigh i mBun Cranncha agus Eaglais Naomh Cairtriona sna Cealla Beaga. Choimisiúnaigh an Oifig Oidhreachta breithmheasanna tréithe ar Limistéir Chaomhantais Ailtireachta sna cúig bhaile oidhreachta atá ag Contae Dhún na nGall, mar atá Ard an Rátha, Béal Átha Seanaidh, Bun an Phobail, Ráth Mealtain agus Ráth Bhoth. San obair seo, aithníodh agus léarscáilíodh na teorainneacha a d'fhéadfadh a bheith ag Limistéir Chaomhantais Ailtireachta, tugadh anailís ghairid stairiúil ar fhorbairt agus ar thréithe gach Baile Oidhreachta, agus rinneadh cur síos ar na tréithe atá ag gach ceann de na Limistéir Chaomhantais Ailtireachta atá beartaithe, chomh maith le straitéis chaomhnaithe. Fuair an Oifig Oidhreachta €24,500 fosta le haghaidh oibreacha caomhnaithe tosaigh chuig Scoil Mhaoinithe an Phríóra i Leifear faoin *Chiste um Struchtúir Stairiúla*.*

Sa phictiúr le linn na n-oibreacha caomhnaithe ar Theach Condon, An Meal, Béal Átha Seanaidh tá Collette Beattie, Oifigeach Caomhantais agus Joseph Gallagher, Oifigeach Oidhreachta. Fuair an Oifig Oidhreachta agus an Oifig Caomhantais maoiniú €237,700 ón gComhairle Oidhreachta do Thionscnamh Bailte Stairiúla Bhéal Átha Seanaidh.

Supporting Vernacular, Built & Archaeological Heritage

Donegal County Council's award-winning *Thatch Repair Grant Scheme* supported 24 thatch repair projects. The Heritage Office and the Conservation Office manages the cross-directorate scheme to provide specialist advice to owners on the conservation of thatch and to allocate funding for small-scale thatch repairs. The scheme attracted national attention and was featured on the RTÉ News, BBC Radio Ulster, BBC Radio Foyle and Newstalk Radio in March. The Community Monuments Fund administered by the Department of Housing, Local Government & Heritage in partnership with the Heritage Office and Conservation Office supported archaeological heritage projects worth €223,500 at Doon Fort, former Kilmacrennan Church of Ireland, Malin Well Church, O'Doherty's Keep in Buncrana and St. Catherine's Church in Killybegs. The Heritage Office commissioned character appraisals of Architectural Conservation Areas in County Donegal's five heritage towns of Ardara, Ballyshannon, Moville, Ramelton & Raphoe. The work identified and mapped the boundaries of potential Architectural Conservation Areas, included a brief historical analysis of the development and character of each Heritage Town, a description of the character of each of the proposed Architectural Conservation Areas and a conservation strategy. The Heritage Office also secured €24,500 for initial conservation works to the Prior Endowed School in Lifford under the *Historic Structures Fund*.

Oideachas agus Feasacht

Lean an Chomhairle oidhreachta, i gcomhpháirtíocht leis an Oifig Oidhreachta agus Ionad Oideachais Dhún na nGall, leis an *Chlár Fíorúil um Oidhreacht i Scoileanna* do pháistí agus do mhúinteoirí i gContae Dhún na nGall. Rinne an Oifig Oidhreachta urraíocht ar léiriú an fhíseáin *Bithéagsúlacht in Éirinn* arna léiriú ag Nature North West agus Charlie Joe Films atá ar fáil ar shuíomh YouTube Chomhairle Contae Dhún na nGall. Mar chuid de *Wainfest* agus i gcomhar le Seirbhís Leabharlainne an Chontae, rinne an Oifig Oidhreachta urraíocht ar Éanna Ní Lamhna chun tabhairt faoi cheardlanna amuigh faoin aer *Wild About Nature* do pháistí i mí Dheireadh Fómhair. Bhí an tSeachtain Oidhreachta Náisiúnta ar siúl ón 14 - 22 Lúnasa agus in ainneoin phaindéim Covid-19 tugadh faoi 57 tionscadal oidhreachta i gContae Dhún na nGall. Is í an Chomhairle Oidhreachta agus Oifig Oidhreachta na nÚdarás Áitiúil a chomhordaíonn Seachtain na hOidhreachta. Ag na Gradaim Oidhreachta Náisiúnta 2021 i mí Dheireadh Fómhair, bhuaigh dhá ghrúpa oidhreachta atá lonnaithe i nDún na nGall gradaim náisiúnta. Mar chuid den Rannán Cultúir agus le maoiniú ón Roinn Turasóireachta, Cultúir, Ealaíon, Gaeltachta, Spóirt & Meán, chuidigh an Oifig Oidhreachta le hiniúchadh a choimisiúnú ar chuimhneacháin a raibh rochtain ag an phobal orthu a bhaineann le Clár Chomóradh an Chéid [1912-1923].

Education & Awareness

The Heritage Council, in partnership with the Heritage Office and the Donegal Education Centre, continued its rollout of the *Heritage in Schools Virtual Programme* for children and teachers in County Donegal. The Heritage Office sponsored the production of the *Biodiversity in Ireland* video produced by Nature North West and Charlie Joe Films that is available on the Donegal County Council YouTube site. As part of *Wainfest* and in association with the County Library Service, the Heritage Office sponsored Éanna Ní Lamhna to undertake outdoor *Wild About Nature* workshops for children in October. National Heritage Week took place from August 14 - 22 and despite the Covid-19 pandemic, 57 heritage projects were undertaken in County Donegal. Heritage Week is coordinated by The Heritage Council and Local Authority Heritage Officers. At the National Heritage Awards 2021 in October, two Donegal-based heritage groups won national awards. As part of the Culture Division and with funding from the Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sports & Media, the Heritage Office helped to commission an audit of publicly-accessible memorials associated with the Decade of Centenaries [1912-1923].

Fuair Comhairle Contae Dhún na nGall maoiniú €45,766 ó Sheirbhís Páirceanna Náisiúnta agus Fiadhúlra na Roinne Tithíochta, Rialtais Áitiúil agus Oidhreachta faoi Chiste an Phlean Gníomhaíochta Náisiúnta um Bithéagsúlacht do thrí thionscnamh: (i) an chéad chéim de shuirbhé chun méid, dáileadh agus cineálacha bogaigh i gContae Dhún na nGall a fháil amach d'fhonn eolas bithéagsúlachta a sholáthar agus bonn eolais a chur faoi chinnteoireacht, (ii) an tríú bliain de thionscadal Tracking Irish Breeding Curlew le Cairde Éanlaith Éireann agus (iii) suirbhé píolótach dhá bhliain ar phórú naoscaí i gContae Dhún na nGall i gcomhpháirtíocht le Cairde Éanlaith Éireann.

Lean Oifigí Oidhreachta agus Oifigí Bithéagsúlachta na nÚdarás Áitiúil i gcomhpháirtíocht leis an Ionad Náisiúnta le Sonraí Bithéagsúlachta ag déanamh urraíochta ar Ghradam Bliantúil Pailneoirí na nÚdarás Áitiúil mar chuid de Chomórtas na mBailte Slachtmhara chun grúpaí áitiúla a spreagadh chun gníomhartha a thacaíonn le pailneoirí a chur i bhfeidhm ina mbailte agus sráidbhailte. Bhuaigh Bailte Slachtmhara Bhun Cranncha an *Gradam Pailneoir Náisiúnta na mBailte Slachtmhara* don dara bliain as a chéile. Chuir Líonra Oifigeach Oidhreachta na nÚdarás Áitiúil, i gcomhpháirtíocht le Rannóg na Gaeilge, Comhairle Contae Dhún na nGall leabhrán *Garraíodóireachta ar son na Bithéagsúlachta* ar fáil.

Wildlife and Biodiversity Initiatives

Donegal County Council secured €45,766 in funding from the National Parks and Wildlife Service of the Department of Housing, Local Government & Heritage under the National Biodiversity Action Plan Fund for three initiatives: (i) the first phase of a survey to determine the extent, distribution and types of wetland in County Donegal in order to provide biodiversity information and inform decision-making, (ii) the third year of a Tracking Irish Breeding Curlew project with BirdWatch Ireland and (iii) the initiation of a two-year pilot survey of breeding snipe in County Donegal in partnership with BirdWatch Ireland.

Local Authority Heritage Offices and Biodiversity Offices in partnership with the National Biodiversity Data Centre continued to sponsor the annual Local Authority Pollinator Award as part of the *Tidy Towns* Competition to encourage local groups to implement pollinator-friendly actions in their towns and villages. Buncrana Tidy Towns won the *National Tidy Towns Pollinator Award* for the second year in a row. The Local Authority Heritage Officer Network in partnership with the Irish Language Office, Donegal County Council produced the *Garraíodóireachta ar son na Bithéagsúlachta* booklet.
